



International workshop

Current trends in Central European research of modern history, politics and culture

29 – 31 May, 2019 Palacký University Olomouc, Czech Republic

Organized by the CEEPUS network CIII-CZ-0029 and the Department of History, Faculty of Arts in Olomouc

Aim:

- to bring together students from the network's universities who work on similar topics of MA theses and PhD. dissertations
- to provide students with deeper insights into their research by thematic lectures and workshops
- to offer space to discuss, exchange and develop ideas about joint PhD. programs and joint PhD. dissertations (theses en cotutelle)

Who can apply?

- students at Masters level as well as early- and mid-stage PhD. students enrolled at networks' universities (EU citizens)
- an excellent command of English is a prerequisite
- students interested in the following topics:
- 1) Memories and memory politics in contemporary Central Europe
- 2) Memory and anthropological perspectives
- 3) Cultural heritage and the memory of the everyday life in Central Europe
- 4) The European Union and its future
- 5) Central Europe and its modern history
- 6) Central and South Eastern Europe in the International Relations of 20th and 21st Century
- 7) Cultural transfer and intercultural relations

How to apply?

A motivation letter detailing why you wish to participate in this CEEPUS workshop, together with a topic and an abstract of your dissertation (about 200 words) and your CV including your academic career is to be sent to two emails: 1) radmila.svarickova@upol.cz, 2) your institutional coordinator natasza.styczynska@uj.edu.pl We only accept electronic applications sent via e-mail.

The deadline for applications is 23 November 2018.

Successful candidates will be notified by the end of November 2018.

The costs of the workshop are covered by the CEEPUS scholarship (students will receive a scholarship of about 3 000 CZK) and will pay the cost of their accommodation and their meals out of it). Refreshments during workshops and two receptions will be offered by Palacký University Olomouc.

Accommodation

All students will be accommodated at the student's dormitory "generála Svobody" of Palacký University. Accommodation will be booked and students will pay it themselves from their scholarship (cost per one night in a room shared by two persons: 280 CZK, single room: 400 CZK).
