Egle has an extensive experience in both EU, international affairs and strategic planning in the public policy area. She has obtained Master of Arts degree in Medieval Studies of the University of Leeds, UK. She has also improved her professional knowledge and received additional training in the EU affaires, negotiations techniques, public management, strategic planning and leadership programmes in Lithuania and abroad.

Egle served two terms as cultural attaché in Brussels during the period of 1999-2005 and 2019-2021. She was involved in Lithuania's EU membership negotiations in 2001-2003.
