Maja Urbańska is an EU official working at the European External Action Service (EEAS) where she occupies the position of Head of the Political, Information and Communication Section at the EU Delegation in Morocco. Prior to this, she was Acting Head of Division for EU Relations with the USA and Canada. She also worked as a Team Leader in the Iran Task Force, in charge of the implementation of the JCPOA, EU-Iran bilateral relations and regional issues.

Between 2011 and 2015, Ms Urbańska served as the advisor to the Deputy Secretary-General of the EEAS in charge of security and defence policy. Her responsibilities included a wide range of fields such as conflict prevention/mediation, human rights and development cooperation. Before the creation of the EEAS, she worked in the Cabinet of the European Parliament's President Jerzy Buzek.

Before moving to Brussels, Ms Urbańska was an employee of the Jagiellonian University in Kraków, and worked in the private sector as a public relations officer.
